About Dr. Frederik Schroyens:

Dr Schroyens is a 1977 medical graduate of the State University of Gent (Belgium) and a 1978 graduate of the Faculty for Homeopathy in London (MFHom). He has maintained an exclusively classical homoeopathic practice since 1978.

Dr. Schroyens was a founding member of the VSU, largest Flemish School for Homeopathy and also served as its president for about 10 years. VSU has provided one-year introductory training in homeopathy to more than 1000 students and has fully trained over 150 homeopaths in its five-year program. He has also founded the Masi-workshops in Belgium and Holland.

He published an introduction to homeopathy in 1984 in Dutch, which has been translated into French and Portuguese. He is the Editor of "Synthesis", which has also expanded the computer based Repertory linked to the RADAR computer project since 1987. Dr. Schroyens has been presenting homeopathic lectures and seminars for many years, in most European countries as well as North and South America. He recently extended his teaching to India, Eastern Europe and South Africa.

Dr. Master F J was born in 1957, February 24th in Mumbai, India. He studied homeopathy at the L.C.E.H.(Goldmedallist) and M.D.(Hom.) (University of Rajasthan)

He has been teaching since 1980, and is affiliated with the Hahnemann College of homeopathy (UK, Canada), London college of Homeopathy (UK), Norks Akademi for Natumedisin (Oslo), Small Poland Homeopathic Physicians Associations (Krakow), Magyar Homoeopata Orvosi Egyesulet (Budapest), Osterrichische Gesellschaft fur Homeopathische Medizin (Vienna). He teaches on a regular basis all over Europe, India and the United States.

He is a professor of Homeopathic Materia Medica at Homeopathic Medical College in Bombay. He is Doctor of Medicine in Homeopathy awarded with Gold Medal. He authored 35 books. Dr. Master is the editor of Homeopathic Heritage, India and an ex-member of the Central Council of Homeopathy, Ministry of Health and welfare, Govt. of India.

About Mussoorie:

Popularly known as the Queen of Hills, this charming hill station is 34 kms. from Dehradun, and is situated at an altitude of 2,500 mts. above sea-level. The enchanting view of pine covered hill slopes and snow capped mountains leave an indelible impression on anyone that visits this magnificent place. The modern bungalows, malls and well laid gardens which are located on the small hills around the area will enchant and entice you to return again and again.

Below Mussoorie is the Doon Valley, which is situated between the two most important rivers of India, the Ganga and the Yamuna. This picturesque valley has a moderate climate and offers a number of places of interest to the tourist. The renowned religious town of Rishikesh, the famous 'sulphur springs' at Sahastradhara - Rajaji National Park and the quiet Chakrata hills all lie in this district.

Prime attractions in and around Mussoorie:

- **Lal Tibba:**

This place is the highest point in Mussoorie. Lal Tibba is located in the Landour area which is the oldest inhabited place in Mussoorie. It was here that British first settled. The buildings, the architecture, etc. reveals an English past. After India gained independence, many Britishers settled here. Even the name, Landhour was given by British. In 1967, the municipal corporation of Mussoorie ordered a Japanese Telescope which is placed on Lal Tibba. Through this telescope one can have a lovely view of many peaks in Himalayan range like Badrinath, Kedarnath, Banderpunch etc. Lal Tibba is considered as most beautiful place in Mussoorie
- **Gun Hill:**

Gunhill is the second highest point in Mussoorie. From Gunhill, Mussoorie appears to be changing colors every other minute and with each moment a different scene appears before your eyes. There are many shops on the hill top which make it a wonderful place for a picnic.
- **Municipal Gardens:**

The municipal gardens, also known as Botanical gardens of Mussoorie. These gardens were laid by famous geologist Dr. H. Fackner in the last century.
- **Kempty Falls:**

Kempty Falls are located 13 kms from Mussoorie. This place was developed as a tourist destination by John Mekinian after 1835.
- **The Tapkeshwar Temple**

An ancient place of worship dedicated to Lord Shiva, this cave temple is beside a stream on the banks of a seasonal river. This is the venue for the Shivratri mela each year. The temple is situated on the banks of a rivulet, in the Garhi Cantt. People in large numbers participate in the fair organized on the occasion of Shivratri and pay their obeisance to the deity. Cool sulphur springs around the temple make excellent bathing spots for pilgrims.
- **The Rajaji National Park**

The park is situated at the edge of the sprawling Dehradun valley, nestled in the lush valley of the Shivalik Range, the park is an ideal holiday resort with its many picnic spots and excursion sites.

Excursions from Dehradun:

- Rishikesh
A celebrated spiritual and religious situated on the right bank of the River Ganga, Rishikesh enjoys a calm environment, impressive water front and dense forest hills. Virtually a town of saints, sages and scholars, there are a number of Ashrams where religious discourses are held for the benefit of the visitors. The place is also a renowned center for Yoga teachings. As a matter of fact, this is the place that the Beatles came to meet the Maharishi Mahesh Yogi.
- Sahastra Dhara
Located 14 km from Dehradun is the famous picnic spot called the Sahastra Dhara, which is noted for their astounding beauty the medicinal sulphur waterfalls!
- Lakha Mandal Temple
Lakhamandal is situated on a hill slope along the bank of the Yamuna in the Dehradun district. This site is rich with ancient remains of temples, sculptures and inscriptions, some dating from as early as fifth century A.D.
- Laxman Sidh
This picturesque place about 12 Kms. from Dehradun on Hardwar road is frequented by a large number of people, especially on Sundays and is connected by a local bus service. Legend has it that a saint underwent penance at this place.
